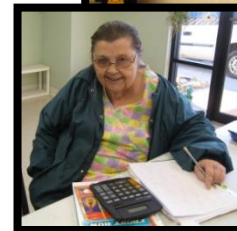


All PROCEEDS GO TO SUPPORT CCS
